Buttons

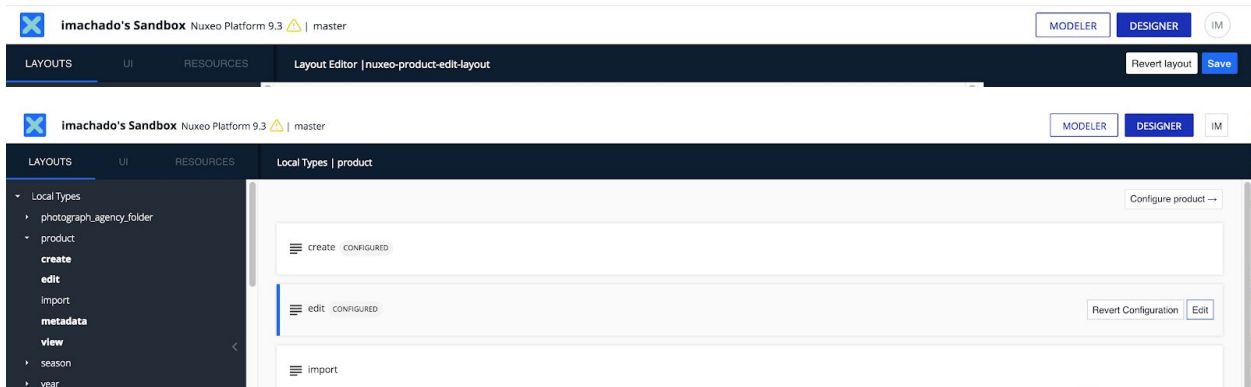
On the top we are constantly seeing two pills, that navigate between Modeler Studio & Designer. They are in their own style, not aligned with the remaining style around Studio.

We find a constant visual conflict between those two rounded pills and other radius-free buttons right below. Since the brand is pretty angular and dynamic, and having on account that the biggest piece of UI elements found around studio are rectangular, I suggest to adapt the pills (& general buttons) for a 2px border-radius.

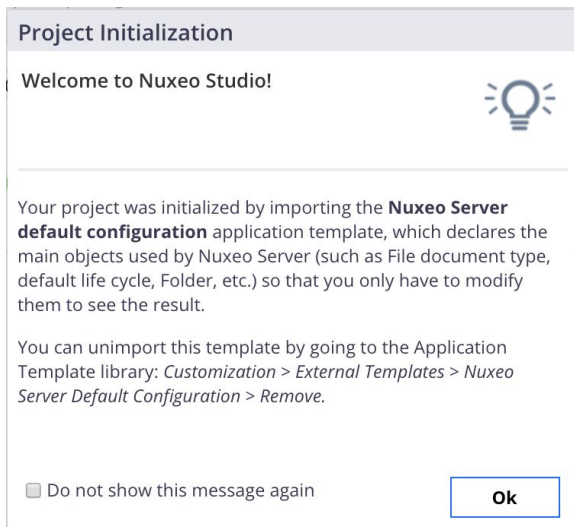

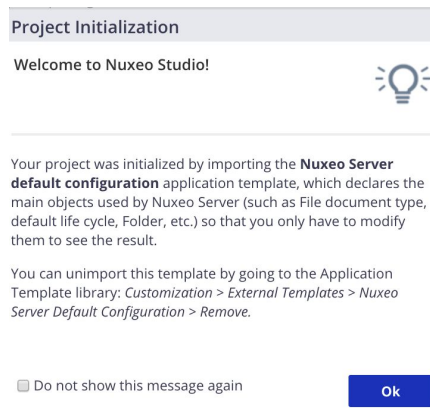
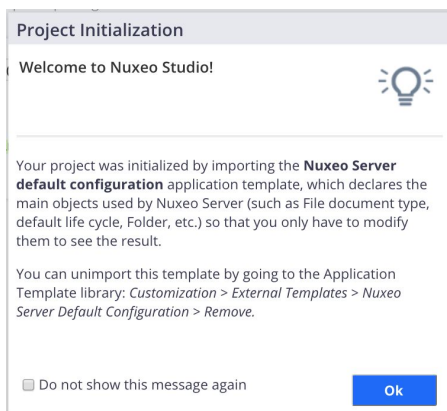
The general positive action buttons should have a stronger visual impact.

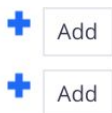

CREATE



Question: Why is it cancel is on the right and save on the left here?

Aligned with the most expected usability order of actions, I would suggest:

Cancel (1) / Discard Changes (2) / Save (3)

- (1) Active - text #7F8284 and button with border 1px #7F8284 no-fill)
Hover - text #0066FF and button with border 1px #0066FF no-fill)
- (2) Active - text #FFFFFF and button color #1F28BF)
Hover - text #FFFFFF and button color #000099)
- (3) Active - text #FFFFFF and button color #0066FF)
Hover - text #FFFFFF and button color #035CE3)

General buttons CSS - if possible

Main action buttons should apply the following standard rules:

- Main positive ACTION (example - Save):

border-radius: 2px;

color: #ffffff;

font-size: 14px;

background: #0066ff;

padding: 10px 20px 10px 20px;

text-decoration: none;

:hover

background: #035CE3;

text-decoration: none;

- Main negative ACTION (example - Cancel):

border-radius: 2px;

color: #7F8284;

font-size: 14px;

background: #FFFFFF;

padding: 10px 20px 10px 20px;

border: solid #7f8284 1px;

text-decoration: none;

:hover

background: #FAFAFA;

text-decoration: none;

Modal Screens

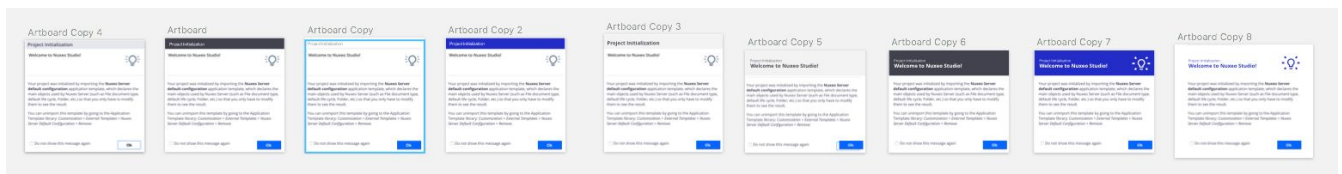
The headers (top bar) of the modal screens are also with an outdated look and feel, not reflecting the innovative style of Nuxeo. It would transmit a stronger feeling of strong/future-oriented software if the style would be something more clean and strong.

Analysis:

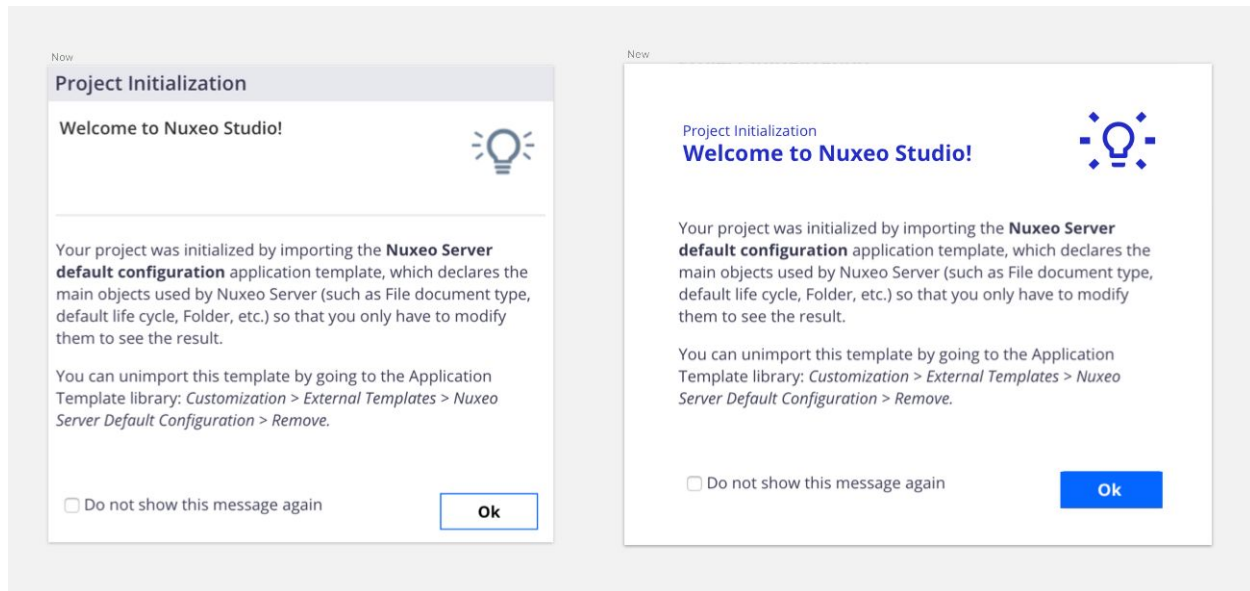
- The styling of the headers should abandon the pale color #e3e8f3
- They should 'breathe' better to be more visually appealing
- The reading hierarchy should respect the more important message to pass. In this case: 'Welcome to Nuxeo Studio' should be more impactful & 'Project Initialization' is secondary information



Creative Process - looking for alternatives:



Suggested Improvement:



- Generous margin of 30px all around
- H1: regular, 12px, #1F28BF
- H2: bold, 18px, #1F28BF
- No border dividing
- Positive action button with strong color #0066FF and white text
- Icons should also assume #1F28BF

If possible, this should be transversal to all the modal screens in Studio and Designer.
